

# **Talents**

## **LITURGICAL MINISTERS**

### **Musicians/Song Leader**

Lead the congregation in song for a Mass as a soloist or in a small group. Select music for the Mass.

### **Eucharistic Minister**

Assist at Mass by distributing the Body and Blood of Christ. Eucharistic Ministers are also needed to take communion to the homebound. A Eucharistic Minister must be a confirmed member of the Catholic Church.

### **Usher/Greeters for Mass/Offertory Gift:**

Bring the offertory gifts to the altar at Mass. Greeters create a hospitable environment by cheerfully welcoming parishioners and visitors as they enter and leave church. Also hand out the bulletin at the end of Mass.

### **Eucharistic Minister for the Homebound**

Bring communion to the homebound

### **Lector**

Proclaim the Scriptures during liturgies and occasionally assist with intercessions.

### **Mass Servers**

Mass Servers assist the priest throughout the Mass. When new servers start, contact the parish office for instructions. Assist the priest for Funeral Mass.

### **Rosary Leaders**

Lead the rosary prior to daily and weekend Masses.

### **Eucharistic Adoration**

Parishioners gather every Friday at appointed times for prayer before the Blessed Sacrament.

### **Stations of the Cross**

Lead the parishioners in the Stations of the Cross during Lent.

## **Parish Life**

### **Catechist**

Teach students in our CCD classes (Wednesday, 3:30 – 5 PM) for Pre – School through 6 grades.

Teach students in our CYO classes (Wednesday, 7:30-9:00) 7-12 grades

Help with the summer reading program

### **Religious Education Subs**

Teach students when regular teachers can't make it.

### **Bookstore Helpers**

Help with the bookstore on weekends with sales and help restock shelves.

### **Environment/decorating for church seasons:**

Work to create a worship environment that follows liturgical guidelines and enhances seasonal celebrations. Support is needed especially at Easter, Christmas and other important feast days

### **Decorating for all Sacraments/Senior Sunday:**

Help with decorating for the sacraments and special events in the basement of the church.

### **Office Help**

Provide assistance within the Parish office

### **Adult Bible Study leaders/Participant**

Participate in and / or lead small group discussions to further our Catholic

### **Parish Movie Night**

Help with making popcorn, setup and clean up.

### **Men/Women Catholic Book Club**

A study to further our Catholic

### **Craft Projects**

Sewing, repairing items and doing other projects to help others.

### **Welcoming Committee for New Parishioners**

Deliver a welcome package to new members.

### **Church/rectory cleaning in spring and fall**

Assist cleaning of the church as needed. Churching cleaning times will be listed in the bulletins.

### **Assist in the RCIA or RCIA**

Rite of Christian initiation of adults and children, primarily designed for those who are interested in joining the Catholic Church.

### **Assist with God Share and Fall Collection**

### **Food Pantry Volunteer**

Volunteers to help set up for the Food Pantry and deliver the food to the Pantry

### **Photography**

Help with taking pictures for special celebrations at Mass.

### **Youth Group Advisor/Committee**

### **Christian Mothers**

Catholic Women group that offers education, service and spiritual fellowship.

Groups of volunteers who serve at parish events and funerals. You will be assigned in a rotation to serve, prepare for, and/or bring food.

### **Right to Life (Prolife Activities)**

### **Stewardship Committee**

Informing fellow parishioners about stewardship and what it means. Help with the annual Stewardship Renewal.

### **Hospital/Home bound visitation**

Compassionate and caring people to visit the sick and home bound.

### **Prayer Chain**

A chain of parishioners who pray for special intentions.

Catholic men’s group that offers education, service and spiritual fellowship.
